

Want to Start a Home-Based Child Care Business?

Grant opportunities are available for income-eligible individuals in **Franklin** county who want to start their own Professional Type-B home-based child care business. Must be at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Income Guideline (see reverse side for the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines).

Individuals completing the program are **eligible for grant dollars** for start-up and operation of the business.

To complete the program, participants are required to:

- Complete the process for a **Professional Type B Child Care Certification** through the Children's Hunger Alliance.
- Receive **Financial Education Training** provided by INCREASE CDC. (Free)
- Receive **Business Training** provided by INCREASE CDC (Free)
- Receive **Family Child Care Training & Technical Assistance** from your local Job & Family Services

Additional benefits and *free* technical assistance available for business start-up and operation.
